**Summary of Role:**

Reporting to the Value Stream Leader and working as part of a supportive team, the Technician would be responsible for manufacturing a wide range of complex parts.

**Key Tasks and Responsibilities:**

- Layering pre-cut, pre-preg sheets of material on to an aluminum tool to create a specific component for a customer (referred to as “Laminating”)
- Following specific work instructions and Standard Operating Procedures (with full training provided by an experienced Laminator)
- Preparing laminated components for the autoclave; this involves wrapping the component in protective material and positioning it in a vacuum bag.
- Assisting with loading and unloading Autoclave as and when required
- Inspecting completed components to ensure they meet the required standard before they leave the department
- Ensuring that the components are properly protected for transportation to the next department
- Responsible for maintaining all tools to a satisfactory condition and always ensuring adherence to health and safety requirements
- Maintaining a safe and clean working environment
- Governance and compliance to company policies; all statutory regulations, QHSE and HR procedures.
